**Petition Circulation! February 16 – March 9, 2010.** Why not volunteer to circulate a petition for your candidate? Before candidates can run for any office, they must file nominating petitions with the Board of Elections. The minimum number of signatures range from ten for candidates for municipal office to 2,000 for some statewide candidates.

By gathering signatures on a candidate's petition, you make it possible for that candidate to appear on the ballot and provide a personal link between the candidate and every voter you contact in this effort.

To sign a Republican candidate's petitions,

- Must be a registered voter living in the same district you are circulating the petition.
- Must be registered as the same party as the candidate. Exception – Judge and School Board candidates can cross file.
- Sign their name and address as it is recorded at the Elections Bureau.
- Ditto marks cannot be used.
- List the date on which they signed the petition.
