

Voter Registration Guidelines when filling out the PA Voter Registration Form

- * Must use legal name and signature. No nicknames.
- * Printed name on line 3 must match signature i.e. Richard E. Smith / Rick Smith.
- * **PA Drivers License number and/or the last 4 digits of Social Security number are required and must be legible.** They will be checked through the SSA or PENNDOT.
- * Voter should fill out the registration him/herself unless unable.
- * Print must be legible!
- * If a voter is unable to sign, DO NOT sign for him/her.
- * Inform the voter that he/she will need to show approved ID the first federal election.
- * If voter neglects to complete some items, DO NOT FILL IN THE BLANKS.
- * A complete residential address is required in Box 4a No PO Boxes, SMC or business addresses (use box 5). Use the physical address of your dorm if registering at school.
- * Submit forms to the county in which the person is registered. Inside the form is a listing of each county Board of Election in the state of Pennsylvania.

THE DEADLINE FOR VOTERS TO REGISTER IS APRIL 19, 2010 FOR THE 2010 PRIMARY ELECTION or OCTOBER 4, 2010 FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION. THE FORM MUST BE POSTMARKED BY THIS DATE. DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE!
