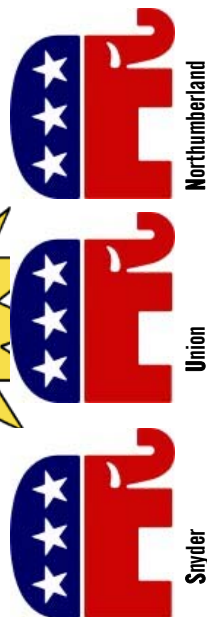
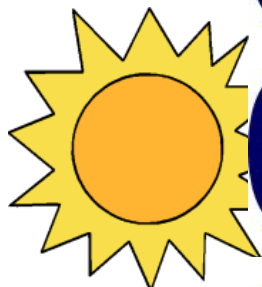

Notice—Meeting date change—

The SUN Area Council of Republican Women usually meet the first Thursday of the month. However, the January 2011 meeting has been changed to **THURSDAY, JANUARY 13, 2011 AT 6:30 PM IN UNION COUNTY**. At this meeting we will be voting on amending our by-laws. If you are a voting member and have not received the changes, please notify Irene Harris. We will also be electing officers for 2011—2013; this election was tabled at the December meeting until the January meeting.

The SUN Area Council of Republican Women met in November and discussed the past election and where our mission lies in the future. We have planned the first quarter of 2011 to focus on advocacy and educating others on advocacy. We were pleased with the 2010 General Election results; but if we do not remain active in issues coming up and how those elected are voting we have not won a victory. Those representing our districts are important, but we need to hold all those elected accountable as our district representatives cannot make a change by one vote.

PFRW/NFRW programs are important and we plan to continue such as Caring for America, Support Our Troops, etc, but our main focus will be advocacy and accountability. Business meetings will be kept at a minimum.

Union County (place TBA).**

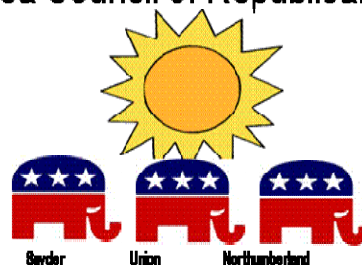
