Application for the Anne B. Anstine Memorial Scholarship

Deadline Date for Filing: March 30, 2013

General Information

The Pennsylvania Federation of Republican Women provides assistance to an undergraduate student, primarily for tuition. Applicants to the scholarship program must be a female, in her final year of secondary school at the time of application. Additionally, the parents, grandparents or legal guardians of the student are required to be members, in good standing, of the Pennsylvania Federation of Republican Women. The Anne B. Anstine Scholarship may be used for college costs at four year colleges and universities, two year junior or community colleges or post-secondary certificate programs.

Selection Criteria

The Anne B. Anstine Scholarship is awarded to an outstanding student who is selected by the scholarship committee on the basis of factors relating to academic performance and leadership potential. These factors are: high school grades, Scholastic Achievement Test scores and extra-curricular activities.

A. EVIDENCE OF LEADERSHIP POTENTIAL:
